

There are two application processes – one for Camosun College and one for the Victoria Conservatory of Music (VCM).

Both must be complete by the deadline for which you are applying (February 28, April 15, June 1).

Applications submitted after June 1-July 30 are accepted only when space exists, upon recommendation from VCM postsecondary faculty.

### APPLICATION FORM (INTERNATIONAL)

Submit the [International Student Application Form](#) then more instructions and information will be provided by your admissions officer.

There are two basic admission requirements for Camosun:

1. You must be 19 years old by your first day of studies at Camosun.
2. Or, completed high school.

For direct entry into academic programs, Camosun requires Canadian Grade 12 English with a minimum C+. Academic IELTS and TOEFL taken within the last two years are accepted.

English requirement for direct entry:

- Academic IELTS score of 6.0 with no individual band less than 6.0
- TOEFL iBT score of 78 with no score less than 19 on each level

If you do not have these requirements, you must write an assessment test upon your arrival at the College. *Requirements are subject to change without notice.*

Diploma in Music Performance: **\$85 Canadian**

Certificate in Music Technology / Creativity: **\$50 Canadian**

**TRANSCRIPTS:** Camosun requires an official transcript. High school and postsecondary transcripts should be sent directly to Camosun's Admissions department. Please mail your official, sealed transcripts to:

**TRANSCRIPTS:** VCM requires an unofficial copy or scan of the transcript. This can be uploaded with the online form, or sent by email or mail along with the rest of your application (see above for email/mail address).

**REFERENCE LETTERS:** Two letters of reference which can be uploaded with the online form, or sent by email or mail along with the rest of your application (see above for email/mail address).

Your references may also send their letters separately by email or mail. Please give them ample time to complete the letter on time

### AUDITION AND THEORY PLACEMENT ASSESSMENT (TPA):

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, audition videos and TPAs are now accepted online. The scheduled TPA and dates to submit audition material are:
