



# Jaymac Scholarship Fund Information

## Notice for Students:

Funded by an anonymous donor, the **Jaymac Scholarship** is particularly for Instrumental Gary Karr Young Artists Performance Academy students.

The terms of the Jaymac Scholarship are:

- The fund will support *full year Academy Program tuition* for two or more deserving students, representing instrumentalists who meet the admission requirements of the Intermediate or Senior Conservatory Gary Karr Young Artists Performance Academy program.

Students will provide:

1. A satisfactory explanation in 150 words or less as to their financial need, their reasons for wanting the opportunity, and how they expect it to benefit themselves or others in the future.
2. A strong character reference from an unrelated adult (from outside the Academy program and NOT their principal instrument teacher)

Funds are available for 2026/27 tuition. Academy applicants wanting to be considered for these scholarships **must apply** as described above by the **deadline of Monday, May 4<sup>th</sup>**.

- These very special scholarships do not have a family maximum income limit and are based on a mix of financial need and merit.
